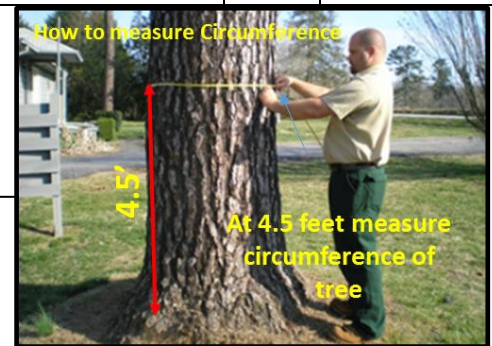

**\*City defines Specimen trees as:**

- If DBH is greater than 24 inches for large hardwoods – oaks, maples, hickories, poplars, ash etc.
- If DBH is greater than 30 inches for softwoods – pines, cedars, spruce etc.

**Question and Answer**

**Q** - Do I need a permit to remove **less than 10 trees** on my property?

**A** – A permit is not required, however you do need to ensure you have met the canopy coverage outlined below. If you are not able to determine the canopy coverage please fill out the application and supporting documentation and the City will be happy to assist you. There is no cost associated with this application. The canopy requirement is provided below. You are not permitted to remove trees required by zoning or located in a stream buffer or a floodplain.

**Table 12-1  
Minimum Tree Canopy Coverage Requirements by Land Use**

<b>Land Use</b>	<b>Minimum Tree Canopy Coverage Required (% of development site or lot)</b>
Residential, single-family attached or two-family	20%
Residential, multiple-family	20%
Residential, fee simple townhouse	15%
Office or institutional	20%
Commercial	15%
Industrial	10%
Mixed use	20%

Required document:

- Application
- A site plan showing location of the trees to be removed and location of the trees (s) required to be planted.
- Photos of tree/s to be removed
- If tree to be removed is a Specimen Tree, please provide letter from Arborist

**Q** – Do I need a permit to remove **more than 10 trees** on my property?

**A** – In removing more than 10 trees a land disturbance permit will be required. The cost will be \$150 the following documentation will be required:

- Application
- Land disturbance plan - plan showing trees to be removed and how erosion will be prevented.
- Landscaping - plan showing tree replacement (canopy coverage must be met).
- Photos of trees to be removed
- If tree to be removed is Specimen Tree, please provide letter from Arborist

You are not permitted to remove trees required by zoning or located in a stream buffer or a floodplain.

**Q** – How do I know if the trees to be removed includes a specimen tree?

**A** – The application provided shows the steps in determining if a tree is a specimen tree.

**Q** – How long is the review process?

**A** – The review process may take 5 to 10 business days.

**Q** – What will happen if I do not meet the canopy requirement?

**A** - The applicant will be required to replant trees or add additional trees. Any other requirement by the City will be communicated to the applicant.
